PRODUCTIVITY TIP #22

If you ever find yourself sending an email attachment, you can save yourself a few steps by attaching the file before you compose the message. Find the file on your computer you would like to attach and right click on it. You should see a menu appear including “Send To” options. Pick the “Groupwise Recipient” from the context menu and a new Groupwise window will appear with your file already attached. By doing this no longer have to open and search for the attachment, plus you have the bonus of making sure the file is attached before you send the email. Now you won't get those pesky return emails complaining you didn't attach the file.
