PRODUCTIVITY TIP #5

Papers take long enough to write without worrying about format problems. A feature of Word that can help with longer papers is the ability to use styles. While working in Word simply select the format drop-down menu and choose "styles and formatting." You can define size, font, color and attributes for any of the predefined styles that appear or you can create your own new style. While working, simply place the cursor in the paragraph to format and then click the style. Your paragraph will be formatted instantly. You can also change the style to apply to headers, footers, etc.

Stellarium is an open source project allowing for exploration of space. The program features accurate depictions of the night sky, allows for exploration of constellations in 12 different cultures, and even allows you to add in your own objects or create your own constellations.
